

Regulations for Rewarding Students of I-Shou University for Passing Foreign Language Proficiency Tests

Article 1 The Regulations for Rewarding Students of I-Shou University for Passing Foreign Language Proficiency Tests (hereinafter referred to as “the Regulations”) are made by I-Shou University (hereinafter referred to as “the University”) to encourage students

to learn foreign languages actively, gain a competitive edge, and connect with the international community.

Article 2 The term “foreign languages” mentioned herein refers to English, Japanese, Korean, French, German, Thai, and Vietnamese.

The term “overseas students” mentioned herein refers to students admitted to the University under the Regulations Regarding International Students Undertaking Studies in Taiwan.

Article 3 During the period of studying at the University, students who have taken one of the foreign language proficiency tests, met one of the criteria stated in the Appendix below and obtained a certificate are eligible to apply for a reward. (For new students admitted in the fall semester, the period of studying starts on August 1 of the year of admission; for new students admitted in the spring semester, the period of studying starts on February 1 of the year of admission.) Each student is permitted to apply for the reward for each level only once and is strictly prohibited from applying for a lower level after applying for a higher one. Overseas students and overseas Chinese students are not permitted to apply for a reward if they have taken a language proficiency test where the language is the official language of their country of origin.

The aforesaid new students admitted in the fall and spring semesters refer to students the University intends to recruit based on the program proposal made within the prescribed deadline and approved by the Ministry of Education.

Article 4 Application periods:

1. Applications are accepted in March and September every year. The actual application period is subject to an official announcement. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the deadline for application by graduating students is May 31 every year.
2. For test results meeting one of the criteria below between August 1 of the previous year and January 31 of the current year, applications for the reward are accepted in March; and for those between February 1 and July 31 of the current year, applications for the reward are accepted in September.

Article 5 The reward scheme consists of four levels, and the criteria for each level are listed in

the Appendix.

The reward amounts may vary from year to year, depending on the annual budget and the test results.

- Article 6 To apply for the reward, applicants shall submit the following:
1. a photocopy of the front and back of the student ID card;
 2. the test report (both the original and a photocopy; the original is returned to the applicant after verification while the photocopy is kept by the University);
 3. a photocopy of the passport and a photocopy of the Alien Resident Certificate (applicable to overseas students, students from Hong Kong, Macau, and the Mainland Area).

Article 7 The Regulations become effective on the third day of promulgation after being adopted by the University Administration Council and ratified by the President.

Note: In case of any disputes or misunderstandings regarding the interpretation of the language or terms of the Regulations, the Chinese language version shall prevail.
