



T-shirts are simple items of clothing which began as undergarments. In the past, clothes were often woven out of coarse materials like wool. T-shirts were worn under these items because they were made of cotton and were more comfortable against the skin. In the early 1900s, T-shirts were issued by the US Navy, and it was common for sailors to remove their heavy uniforms and work only in their T-shirts, since they could be easily cleaned.

T-shirts worn as outerwear found acceptance once Hollywood superstars began wearing them. The turning point came in 1951 when Marlon Brando wore one in the movie *A Streetcar Named Desire*. People copied his style, and in the 1960s and 1970s, T-shirts started taking on new looks. T-shirts of all colors began showing up, and ones with words printed on them became standard. Since the late 1980s, prominent designers like Calvin Klein and Ralph Lauren got in on the T-shirt game, taking the garment to a higher level of fashion.

Everyone wears T-shirts these days, and the ones with messages on them are especially trendy. With so many styles, it's easy to find the perfect T-shirt to match your personality.

It is good for our health to drink plenty of water, but buying bottled water is becoming a bigger and bigger problem every single day. The bottling and distribution of water is contributing to some of the planet's worst environmental problems. American cities like San Francisco, Seattle, and Chicago have taken steps to limit the amount of plastic water bottles their residents buy, and the Australian city of Bundanoon has stopped selling them completely.

The plastic from these bottles is made from oil. Bottling the eight billion gallons of water that Americans drink each year could fuel a thousand cars for a whole year. The bottled water industry also adds a lot of pollution to the atmosphere when it transports the bottles all over the world.

Besides the environment, there are health reasons to stop using plastic water bottles. Researchers have found certain chemicals in the plastic that make their way into the water and can eventually cause different kinds of cancer.

One hundred and fifty-seven countries joined this year's World Cleanup Day, in which an estimated 17 million people took part across the world. Almost 100,000 tons of waste was collected, most of which was plastic.

Recording the types of waste collected is important in order to assess the benefits of the cleanups and to encourage a change in behavior, both at the personal as well as the national level. The data collected this year provided a global picture of waste pollution and the most frequently discarded items.

Materials most commonly collected were plastic, glass, and metal. By volume, plastic was the largest waste component. In the Netherlands, for example, plastic represented 59 percent of collected waste, with bottles being the most common plastic found.

Cleanups are important as they can lead to long-term and far-reaching change. To illustrate this point: In 2018, the European Union signed the "Deal on the Single Use Plastic Directive," which targets the use and disposal of the 10 most common single-use plastic items, of which plastic bottles make up the majority.
