The need for emergency housing is more important now than ever before. Many people around the world lose their homes to natural disasters or wars. Tents are the most basic form of disaster shelter. They are light and easy to set up and ship. However, they offer little protection from the cold and are vulnerable to extreme weather, so they are not meant to be long-term housing. Therefore, other types of shelters have been invented.

Some shelters in war zones are made from sandbags and wire. Circular layers of sandbags and wire are laid on top of each other in the shape of a dome and covered to keep water out. There is also a shelter that is a cross between a tent and a permanent house. An inflatable shell is covered with a material called concrete canvas. Once the shell is blown up, water is sprayed on the outside and left to dry. Finally, there is an emergency structure from Japan. The house has two floors, a bathroom, kitchen, and two beds.
